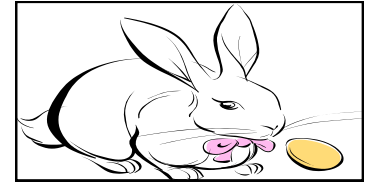
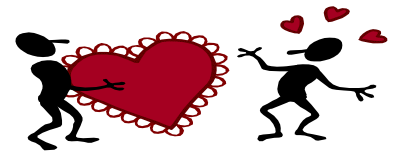

This was AABA’s second and last attempt for providing the Camp. AABA will concentrate on more workshops and activities for Attachment Disorder families.

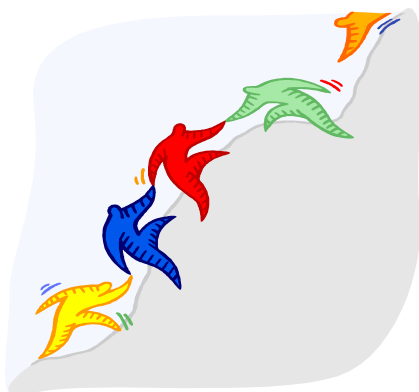

Activity for Attachment Kids

“Bricks 4 Kids” (Lego’s fun)

Alaska Attachment & Bonding Associates has been partnering with **Bricks 4 Kidz** to create a program for attachment disorder children to participate in. Working with Lego's is one of the acceptable activities that children with attachment disorder can participate in. Lego's helps them stay focused while excising parts of their brain.

At Bricks 4 Kidz you can have one on one time with your child and have a fun activity to do, all in one place. Bricks 4 Kidz will have an instructor for guidance, but the caregiver will be the one working with the child to complete a model. Activity for Attachment Kids

“After School Activity for Attachment Disorder Kids & Teens 5-16”

Alaska Assistance Dogs (AAD) is partnering with Alaska Attachment & Bonding Associates (AABA) to bring therapeutic service dog training program to kids and teens with Attachment Disorder. The training program addresses the following core needs: it helps children learn to bond, regulate their emotions, develop impulse control, and experience healthy loving, touching, and hugging. Working with the dogs helps the children develop empathy, patience, and self-esteem. These are the fundamental concerns in Attachment Disorder.

The program helps children gain mental and emotional strength, better equipping them with the skills needed to become a healthy family member. The win-win aspect of this program is that these children are training service dogs for Alaskans with disabilities. These young trainers become active contributing members to the community.

This would be a year long program, based on five once a week sessions in a row with a week break in between. Each five week session would need 6 to 7 new kids. Sessions would be at the Menard Sports Center after school and would run for about 1 ½ hours once a week. Parents or caregivers need to attend along with their child. The program teaches the youngster first and then is teamed up with the parent in various training situations. This is an after school program on Tuesdays. The program needs six to seven kids ages 5 -16 for each 5 week session. **There would be absolutely no cost to the families. It’s free.....**

Extreme Family Makeovers

Nancy Thomas has a Extreme Family makeover program, where she comes to your home. Just think you would have one on one time and training with Nancy in your own home environment, this will help Nancy find out what kind difficulties you are having and help you with the problems.

This program is designed to help families to connect and help challenging children (up to 12 years of age) to redirect their paths at home. The focus of this program is to renew, recharge, and empower each parent with effective techniques to decrease their child's aggression and destruction, while increasing love and laughter in their homes. This is achieved through a powerful in-home program with daily skill building and parenting interventions to build the child's trust, honesty, self-control and conscience development. Nancy's program's has been developed on over 30 years of success working with violent, defiant, destructive children. These children can learn to be respectful, responsible and fun to be with. The cost is less than an intensive one on one at Nancy's Colorado Ranch. Plus you do not have to buy plane tickets, rent a room, buy food, or rent a car.

The cost and days vary with the size of your family.
Families of four or less: Three day makeover is \$4850.
Families of five or six: Four day makeover is \$6450.
Families of seven or more: Five day makeover is about \$8050.

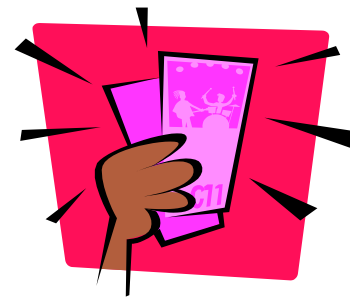
